JCATS Code of Conduct

The JCATS Code of Conduct represents the high standards and values that we abide by as the recognized feeder basketball program of Libertyville High School. The members of our program (e.g., the Board of Directors, Coaches, Players and Parents) will act in accordance with our Code both on and off the court and will be the ambassadors of the program at all external events.

- The Board of Directors will insure that the JCATS program is maintained for the benefit of the Libertyville community and in the best interests of the coaches and players that participate. The Board will provide transparency to the operation of the program by conducting regular Board meetings, issuing meeting minutes, providing financial reports as required, and meeting with all members of the program (e.g., coaches, players and parents) on a periodic basis.
- The Coaches will insure that their teams are acting in accordance with the JCATS values and representing the community during all team functions (e.g., practices, games, tournaments). Coaches will act in the best interest of their players and will be a positive role model for their team. Use of profanity, intimidation, unsportsmanlike conduct or other actions detrimental to the program will not be used at any time by the coaching staff.
- The Players will act in accordance with the JCATS values and positively represent the program, their community, and their team at all team functions. Players will show respect for their coaches, teammates, parents, referees, and opposing players and coaches. Unsportsmanlike conduct or other actions detrimental to the program will not be used at any time by any player.
- The Parents will insure both they and their child act in accordance with the JCATS values and are a positive role model for their child at all team functions. Parents will support the team in a positive manner during all games and will refrain from negative comments or actions directed at opposing players, coaches, fans or referees. Parents will respectfully address concerns with coaches or members of the Board at appropriate times. Parents will be responsible for the conduct of their family members and friends that attend team functions as fans.

Failure to abide by the JCATS Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action by the JCATS Board of Directors. Recurrent issues or complaints can result in, but are not limited to, parents being excused from attending future JCATS team functions, coach and/or player suspensions, and possible removal of a Board member, coach or player from the program.
